Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible for the 2023 SWTA Summer University Scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

The applicant's organization must be a current SWTA member and in good standing.

The applicant's organization must have a Total Operation Funds Expended of less than \$2,500,000 for 2021 based on values from The National Transit Database ([The National Transit Database \(NTD\) | FTA \(dot.gov\)](https://www.fta.dot.gov)).

The applicant should demonstrate a strong interest in the transportation industry and a commitment to furthering their knowledge in this field.

The applicant must have a minimum of 2 years of experience in the transportation industry.

The applicant needs to be available to attend the 2023 SWTA Summer University in Wichita, Kansas on August 13-16, 2023.

The selected scholarship winner must have the financial means to cover their own travel, accommodation, and food and beverage expenses.

Application Process:

Applicants must complete the online scholarship application form, which can be found at [SWTA Summer University 2023 Scholarship Application - South West Transit Association](#).

Applicants will craft a personal statement (maximum 500 words) explaining why they are interested in attending the 2023 SWTA Summer University and how it aligns with their career goals (included in the online scholarship application form).

Optional: Provide any additional supporting documents or reference letters that highlight your commitment to transportation education.

Selection Process:

The selection committee will review all applications based on the eligibility criteria and the quality of the application materials. Successful applicants will demonstrate a strong passion for transportation and a clear motivation to attend the 2023 SWTA Summer University. The committee will notify the selected scholarship recipients via email.

Note: The scholarship covers only the registration fees for the SWTA Summer University. The selected candidate will be responsible for their travel, accommodation, and any other expenses related to attending the program.
